1. ELIGIBILITY :

- Senior Secondary (10+2) CBSE Board or any other equivalent recognized board in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, English, Psychology, Geography, Business Studies, Accountancy, Computer Science/Informatics Practice/Word Processing/Multimedia Civic, History, Political Science, Economics, Commerce, Home Science, Sociology and Mathematics. Preference will be given to candidates with Physics, Chemistry, Biology. The candidate should have 40% or more marks in aggregate in best three subjects. Pass in English is compulsory.
 - Those who have successfully completed ANM Course with aggregate of 40% or more marks (10+2 Vocational) from the school recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
 - For Foreign Nationals**
The entry qualification equivalency is 12th Standard will be obtained by Association of Indian University New Delhi, Institution, State Nursing Council will certify the equivalent to what has been prescribed in print as above.
2. **AGE:**
Age should not be below 17 Years and not more than 35 Years as on 31.12.17 Upper age relaxation of upto five years is given to candidates belonging to SC/ST Category.
